

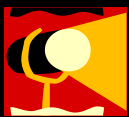

CHAMBER RECEIVES LOCAL SHARE AWARD

Facade Improvement Project Phase III Funded by LSA
(excerpts from Valley Independent article by Chris Buckley)

The MVRCC's popular facade improvement project received an award for another round of funding from the Local Share Account in Washington County. The committee recommended a total of \$6.5 million for economic and community development projects, County wide, said Jeff Kotula, local share committee chairman. Kotula said commissioners Larry Maggi, Diana Irely Vaughan and Harlan Shober, "continually challenge the LSA Review Committee each year to recommend impactful and job-creation projects for our county, and I believe the committee has done its work again this year," Kotula said. "Mon Valley projects such as the Vestaburg Waterline Replacement, City of Monongahela's geographic information systems initiative and the Carroll Township municipal and public safety building project will certainly foster economic growth and quality of life in the Valley," he added.

Debbie Keefer, Mon Valley Regional Chamber of Commerce executive director, said the committee recommended the organization's full facade improvement request.

The facade program began in 2010 and in the first two phases, 33 properties underwent improvements. The local share program provided \$93,000 for the improvements, matched by \$223,000 in private investment.

Eligible commercial properties must be within the borough boundaries. A design committee, comprising a cross-section of Charleroi's business community, approves projects for the program.

"The ultimate benefit is that it stimulates private investment in community development," Keefer said. "These are not tax dollars, and the match that the property owners bring to the table are not tax dollars. She said that the Design Committee will meet in the next few weeks to develop the new guidelines, which will most likely conform with the Phase I and Phase II programs. Then it will begin accepting applications for review and approval.

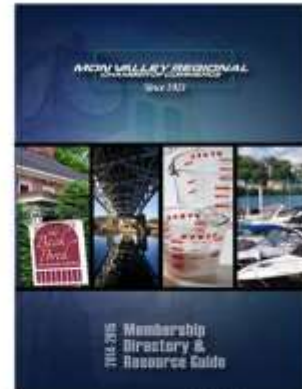

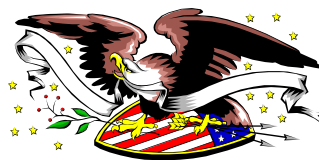
