
April Member Spotlight TREGEMBO MOTORS

Dear Chamber Members,

As spring is in the air and temperatures are reaching the 60s; this can mean a lot for customers who heat their homes and businesses with electricity and who switched from a respectable provider to an alternative provider under the Pennsylvania 2010



deregulation of the electric utility system. Under deregulation consumers are able to buy electricity from several retail providers that compete for your business and residence.

Having the power to choose which company you buy electricity from gives you the chance to shop around and find the best combination of price, product, customer service and consultative experience that can give you peace of mind while you save money off monthly electric bills.

The markets for electricity remain very volatile, and the **Chamber** *Choice* **Energy Program** strives to find the most attractive rates or purchasing options at any given point in time for the Chamber Members. When a third party supply contract is signed, the supplier is securing power on the wholesale market at that point in time for the term of the contract (typically between 12 and 48 months in duration).

Unfortunately, some alternative providers have been aggressively contacting Chamber Members with false or misleading information. And from that misleading information Chamber Members are sometimes signed up for electricity service without their knowledge or consent, an unprincipled activity known as "slamming." Slamming involves someone switching your retail electric provider without your permission. Chamber Members usually don't find out they have been slammed until they get a bill from a different electric company than the one they are supposed to be getting their electricity from.

OnDemand Energy has received numerous calls of confusion and concern from Chamber Members regarding slamming. We would like to warn Chamber Members of the slamming issue that is taking place and remind members who are a part of the Energy Program to please be aware of the issue and if your business has inadvertently or unknowingly been switched, **OnDemand Energy can assist you in reverting the situation in order to avoid any fees.**

To alleviate any issues, please do not provide any personal account information to unknown callers. As the managers of the **Chamber***Choice* **Energy Program**, **OnDemand is** prepared to assist with any uncertainty or questions regarding your current enrollments and rates. 
Good Luck but Not Goodbye to Donna!

MVRCC Hosts PA DCED Secretary C. Alan Walker

115 members and guests were in attendance at a luncheon on April 8 at the Willow Room as a result of a partnership of the Mon Valley Regional Chamber of Commerce, the Greater Rostraver Chamber of Commerce, the Mon Yough Area Chamber of Commerce and the Mon Valley Progress Council.

Secretary Walker discussed Governor Tom Corbett's JOBS 1st PA initiative and the state's economy. Pennsylvania companies increased exports by 5.4 percent in 2013. He pointed to World Kitchen in Charleroi, which was represented at the luncheon as a local example of that success. Mr. Walker stated that the gas and oil industry has and will continue to industrialize the Mon Valley and Western Pennsylvania. He is a proponent of industrial parks, and looks forward to assisting in the development of the former Allenport Wheeling Pittsburgh Plant.
