



The purpose of this financing is to encourage the creation and growth of new and expanding small businesses. The program provides financing at a fixed interest rate for a fixed term. Eligible uses of financing include:

Opening or expanding your business Buying inventory Purchasing equipment Supplementing working capital

WCCED is the largest microloan provider in western Pennsylvania and all of West Virginia; in fact in the past fiscal year, \$.53 of every SBA microloan dollar lent in all of West Virginia and western Pennsylvania was loaned by WCCED.

The SBA microloan can be stand alone or part of a total \$150,000 loan package with a bank. Assistance is available through the SBDC to develop the business plan and financial projections.
