


Member Spotlight GARROW CANINETRAINING



The United Way has provided grants for agencies in the areas of childcare, early intervention, afterschool programs and student scholarships. They also help with adult daycare, in home services for the aging and assistance for individuals and families with drug and alcohol issues. The United Way is most proud of their 2-1-1 programs which match individuals in need for rent, food, healthcare and veteran's needs.

The United Way is governed by a local Board of Directors with a strong diverse background and exceeds all guidelines and standards set forth by United Way Worldwide.

In addition to hosting Washington County's annual day of giving, *WCCF Gives*, the WCCF administers a broad grant-making program and provides free educational seminars for charities serving our community. Cumulatively, more than \$13,500,000 in grants and scholarships has been awarded to local charities and students through the WCCF.
