This year's tournament will be held on June 4, 2026, at Nemaocolin Country Club. More Information inside.

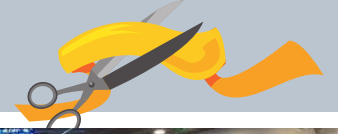

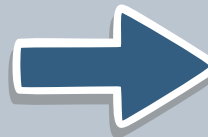
